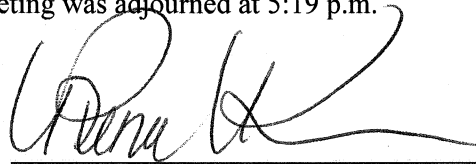
A. Budget Update – Brian Hardy

Mr. Hardy reviewed the Measure R Bond noting that \$45 million was expended on Citrus Valley High School, \$9 million for the modernization project and \$6.5 million for Judson & Brown Elementary. Approximately \$2.9 million remains to be used as other modernization issues arise. Member John Walsh asked if interest was being earned on the remaining funds, Mr. Hardy confirmed. Mr. Hardy also informed members that an arbitrage payment of approximately \$390,000 was required to be paid to the United States Treasury.
